#1 – TruckMap - TruckMap is a useful tool for truck drivers, helping them navigate their routes. With TruckMap, drivers can easily find truck-specific routes that avoid obstacles like low bridges or narrow roads. The app also provides information on truck stops, allowing drivers to locate places for rest, refueling, and meals along the way. TruckMap offers real-time updates on traffic conditions, helping drivers to plan their journeys effectively and avoid congestion. It even notifies drivers about weigh stations on their route, making sure they comply with regulations. TruckMap is free to use & can be downloaded for either IOS or Android.

#2 – CoPilot Truck - CoPilot Truck is an app made just for truckers to help them find their way. It gives routes that are safe for big trucks, considering things like size and weight. The app also shows where to find truck stops and other places they might need on the road. You can try it for free, but after that, you'll need to pay each month or year to keep using it. Prices vary from \$9.99 to \$39.99 a month, depending on what features you may need. This also can run on IOS or Android.

It provides features such as truck stop locations, parking availability, fuel prices, weigh stations, and rest areas. There is real-time updates on road conditions and traffic to help drivers plan their trips efficiently. Trucker Path offers a free version with basic features, while a premium subscription option is available for more access. The premium subscription ranges from \$9.99 to \$19.99 per month, offering truckers more advanced tools to ease their journeys. This can also be downloaded on IOS or Android.
